The Winged Goddess of Victory trophy is one of a kind, hand sculpted for the 19th Amendment Celebration in Kansas. The trophy a porcelain sculpture, approximately 8 inches tall and created by artist Jenny Becker. It will be mounted on a natural sandstone base.

The Winged Goddess of Victory trophy is designed after The Nike of Samothrace. This ancient Hellenistic sculpture originated as the Greek Goddess of Victory and it was sculpted in the 2nd century BC to grace the gardens at the Island of the Gods located in the Aegean Sea. The “Nike” has taken on many forms over the years and this sculpture has been designed to proliferate the spiritual essence of the female strength, leadership and tenacity in our victorious quest. This headless form gives light to all women who’s influences go far beyond the physical realm. The thrust energy of its wings ingratiates the forces that sour through adversity and allow us the successes that have laid the path for those thereafter.

In each Awards category, the top scoring qualifying entry will receive a Winged Goddess of Victory trophy. Those placing 2nd and 3rd in each category will receive an award.
